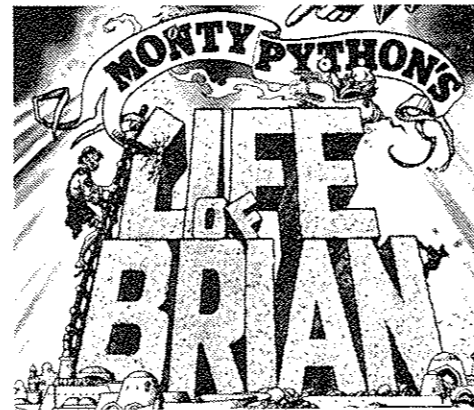
Workshop Speakers Include:

Saturday Night Film Festival / Party



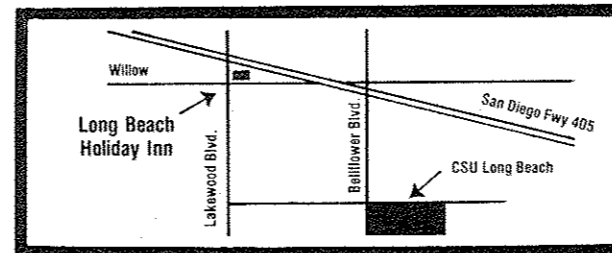
The Festival begins with the hilarious, discordian, anti-political film "Life of Brian". Afterwards, life entertainment and refreshments will be provided.



The 1982 Conference at Cal State University Long Beach

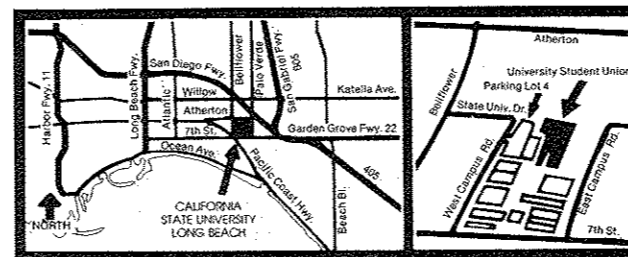
CONFERENCE LOCATIONS

The only event at the Long Beach Holiday Inn is the Friday Night Ayn Rand Tribute Banquet. The Long Beach Holiday Inn is located at 2640 Lakewood Boulevard (corner of Willow and Lakewood Boulevard), just off the San Diego (405) Freeway. Take the Lakewood South off ramp. The Grand Banquet Hall is located just behind the main hotel tower.



California State University, Long Beach is located approximately 27 miles from the Los Angeles International Airport, and the Long Beach Airport is just a few miles from the University. The University's address is 1250 Bellflower Boulevard, Long Beach. From the Los Angeles area, go south on the San Diego (405) Freeway, take the Bellflower Boulevard exit south, follow the signs and then follow the detail map. If you are coming from Orange County or eastern Los Angeles County, take the Seventh Street exit (and go west) from either the Garden Grove (22) or San Gabriel River (605) Freeways.

Transportation from Airports: The Airport Service Bus provides transportation on a regular schedule to and from Los Angeles International Airport and John Wayne (Orange County) Airport. The bus also picks up and delivers to the Long Beach Airport (which is a mile away) where there is a courtesy phone.
