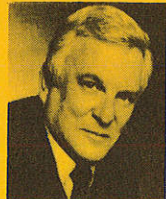

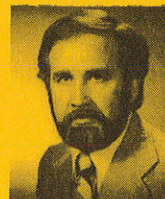

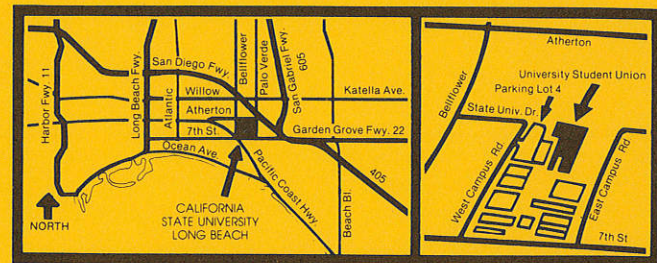

BACKGROUND: Dr. Thomas Szasz, born in Hungary, received an A.B. with Honors in Physics, his M.D. at the University of Cincinnati, diplomate from the national Board of Medical Examiners, diplomate in Psychiatry, American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology. Author of almost 20 books, Szasz is best known for *The Myth of Mental Illness*; Dr. Nathaniel Branden, a former associate of the late Ayn Rand, is author of *The Psychology of Self-Esteem* and currently *The Psychology of Romantic Love*; Douglas Casey, is the author of the bestseller and longest selling financial book in history *Crisis Investing*; Barbara Branden is a former associate of Ayn Rand and the author of the forthcoming biography *The Passion of Ayn Rand*; John Pugsley, a financial advisor, is author of *Common Sense Economics* and *The Alpha Strategy*; Robert LeFevre, author of *The Nature of Man and His Government*, is a newspaper

columnist; Prof. David Friedman, son of Prof. Milton Friedman, has a Ph.D. in Physics and is an assist. Prof. of Economics at UCLA; Gary Charles Hudson, president of G.C.H., Inc., has been active in the space industrialization field for 12 years; Jack Matonis, attorney-at-law for 15 years, is well-known for several anti-government, high court cases; George Smith, author of *Atheism: The Case Against God*, is a research fellow for the Institute for Humane Studies; Jeff Riggerbach, a professional writer and broadcaster, is the executive producer of "Byline," a nationally syndicated radio program; John Hospers, USC professor of philosophy, is the author of over 11 books and ran for President in 1972 on the Libertarian Party ticket; Wendy McElroy is a feminist, writer and contributing editor to "Caliber"; Jeffrey R.
