**10:15 p.m. - 11:45 p.m.** — “Sleeper” (Woody Allen’s 1971 futuristic comedy. Also stars Diane Keaton. Running time: 88 minutes.)

**11:45 p.m. - 12:55 a.m.** — “Duck Soup” (A hysterical Marx Brothers comedy in which Groucho becomes the dictator of Fredonia, a mythical Balkan nation. Running time: 68 minutes.)

### SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26

**9 a.m. - 11 a.m.** — “The Fountainhead” (1948 screen adaptation of Ayn Rand’s famous novel with Gary Cooper as Howard Roark. Running time: 114 minutes.)

**11 a.m. - 12 noon** — Ayn Rand’s Last TV Interviews (Phil Donahue Show, 1979 and Tom Snyder’s Tomorrow, 1980)

**12 noon - 2:40 p.m.** — “Spartacus” (Stanley Kubrick directed and Kirk Douglas stars in this story about a slave revolt in ancient Rome. Running time: 161 minutes.)

**2:40 p.m. - 4:10 p.m.** — “The Atomic Cafe” (Darkly comedic documentary skillfully edited from two decades of government nuclear war propaganda. Running time: 88 minutes)

**4:10 p.m. - 4:30 p.m.** — Short libertarian Documentaries and TV interviews including Robert Ringer, Tibor Machan, Murray Rothbard, Ed Clark, etc.)

**4:30 p.m. - 6 p.m.** — “Rock N’ Roll High School” (Anarchy triumphs in the public schools, as the Ramones’ music incites some fun-loving teenagers to rebellion. Running time: 94 minutes.)

**6 p.m. - 7:30 p.m.** — “The Crimson Pirate” (Burt Lancaster and Nick Cravat star as romantic and individualistic heroes as they overthrow tyranny on the high seas. 1952. Running time: 104 minutes)

**12 Midnight - 3 a.m.** — (Midnight Movie Madness!) — “The Hitchhiker’s Guide to the Galaxy” (Six satirical half-hour episodes of the anti-authoritarian British SF TV series. Based on Douglas Adam’s best selling trilogy. Worth staying up for! Running time: 170 minutes)

**10 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.** — “Harry’s War” (Tax Revolt in America. One man’s heroic struggle against the Internal Revenue Service. This movie will make your blood boil. Running time: 90 minutes.)

**11:30 a.m. - 12 noon** — Ayn Rand interviewed on the Donahue Show. (Repeat)

**12 noon - 2 p.m.** — “Moscow on the Hudson” (Robin Williams stars in this heart-warming comedy about a Russian defecting to America. Running time: 117 minutes.)

**2 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.** — Ayn Rand interviewed on Tom Snyder (Repeat)

**2:30 p.m. - 4:20 p.m.** — “Fahrenheit 451” (Ray Bradbury’s classic anti-censorship parable of a world in which firemen don’t stop fires, but start them—with books! Running time: 111 minutes)

**4:30 p.m. - 6 p.m.** — “The Scarecrow of Romney Marsh” (Walt Disney’s romantic classic starring Patrick McGoohan as a British smuggler and anti-tax rebel during the 1700s. Running time: 115 minutes.)
